It is a bit of a giant old walnut tree that had a branch growing out from it. The branch broke and rotted and an animal got into the rotten part and cleared out a hollow where he could live. It's mysterious—almost spooky inside and the shiny surface is such an elegant walnut color.



Walnut Ball (12" sphere)

This is a very similar Alder bowl to the one I showed last week. I sold that one and so I made another.



Alder Bowl (15" x 7") \$250

Maple bowl with interesting stains. The bowl is quite low and very oval. It is thin and remarkably tough.



Maple Bowl (14" x 4") \$150

I made a set of these before and found another blank while cleaning up my shop.
